

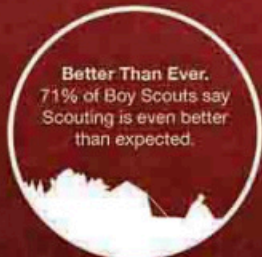
## Council Heritage Society

Since Scouting began in 1910, it's variety of programs helped children succeed and provided a lifetime of memories for each child.

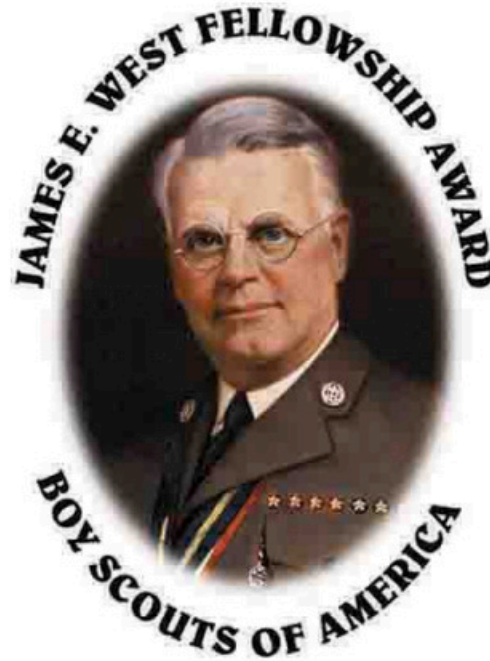

- Provides financial reports on how dollars were used to promote Scouting programs



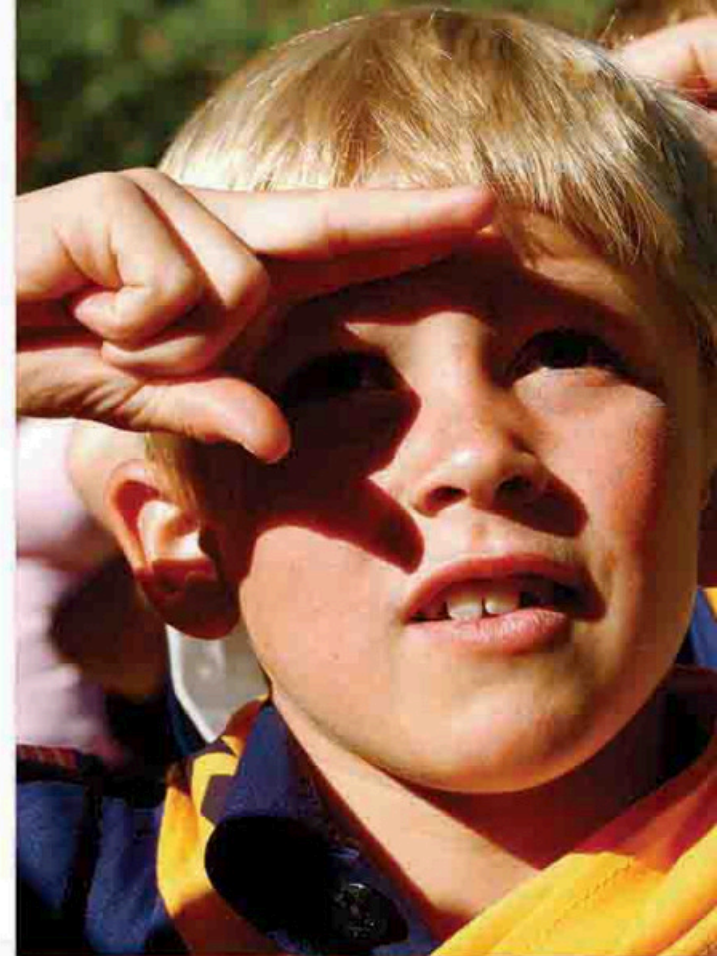

# James E. West Fellowship



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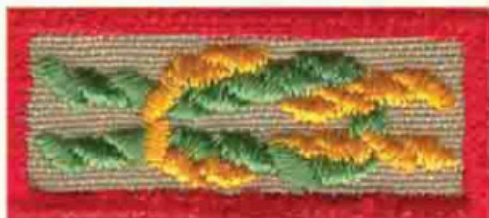
James E. West was the first chief Scout Executive of the Boy Scouts of America, and he served in that position for more than three decades. The West Fellowship award is available for gifts beginning at **\$1,000 and up** in cash or marketable securities to a council endowment fund. The gift must be in addition to and not replace or diminish the donor's annual friends of Scouting support. Many individuals make these gifts either on behalf of someone else, or in memory of a special individual. Examples are such occasions as:

- Honor an Eagle Scout
- Honor a Silver Beaver Recipient
- Memorial gifts or Tribute gifts
- In Honor of a special person

If an institution is truly "the lengthened shadow of one man," it is more than fitting that the BSA honor James E. West's significant contributions to Scouting in such a significant way.
